Thank you for your email on behalf of the Skilled Worker Justice Alliance, and for sharing the concerns of the workers you represent across Greater Manchester. I am responding on behalf of the Mayor.

We share your concerns that the earned settlement proposals risk leaving many residents in a prolonged limbo. In our city region, we believe everyone should have the stability and security they need to live a good life.

As you outline, imposing these proposals on people who are already living and working in the UK would risk creating significant injustice and hardship. This would be counterproductive to our goals to support integration, cohesion and prevention, undermining the work we are doing locally to build strong, connected communities.

In preparation for our response to the Earned Settlement consultation on behalf of NHS GM and GM LAs, we have been engaging with communities and partners and have heard these concerns echoed by residents, employers, and VCFSE organisations from across the city region.

Thank you again for raising this on behalf of the Alliance and for your continued advocacy on behalf of Skilled Worker visa holders in Greater Manchester.
